**Note:** In this document, the phrases “Senior Care Options program” and “Senior Care Options” are used to refer to Commonwealth Care Alliance’s Senior Care Options program.

## What is the Senior Care Options Formulary?

A formulary is a list of drugs covered by the Senior Care Options program. The formulary is chosen by Senior Care Options with help from a team of health care providers. The formulary includes the prescription drugs that we think are necessary for a quality treatment program. Senior Care Options will generally cover the drugs listed in our formulary as long as the drug is medically necessary, the prescription is filled at a Senior Care Options network pharmacy, and other plan rules are followed. For more information on how to fill your prescriptions, please review your Evidence of Coverage.

This document is a partial formulary and includes only some of the drugs covered by Senior Care Options. For a complete listing of all prescription drugs covered by Senior Care Options, please visit our Web site at [www.commonwealthcare.org](http://www.commonwealthcare.org) or call 1-866-610-2273, 24 hours a day, 7 days/week. ## Can the Formulary change?

Generally, if you are taking a drug on our 2010 formulary that was covered at the beginning of the year, we will not discontinue or reduce coverage of the drug during the 2010 coverage year except when a new, less expensive generic drug becomes available or when new adverse information about the safety or effectiveness of a drug is released. Other types of formulary changes, such as removing a drug from our formulary, will not affect members who are currently taking the drug. It will remain available at the same cost-sharing for those members taking it for the remainder of the coverage year. We feel it is important that you have continued access for the remainder of the coverage year to the formulary drugs that were available when you chose our plan, except for cases in which you can save additional money or we can ensure your safety.

If we remove drugs from our formulary, or add prior authorization, quantity limits and/or step therapy restrictions on a drug, we must notify affected members of the change at least 60 days before the change becomes effective, or at the time the member requests a refill of the drug, at which time the member will receive a 60-day supply of the drug. We will notify all members in writing when changes occur to the formulary during the calendar year. If the Food and Drug Administration deems a drug on our formulary to be unsafe or the drug’s manufacturer removes the drug from the market, we will immediately remove the drug from our formulary and provide notice to members who take the drug. The enclosed formulary is current as of January 1, 2010. ## How do I use the Formulary?

There are two ways to find your drug within the formulary:

### **Medical Condition**

The formulary begins on page 6. The drugs in this formulary are grouped into categories depending on the type of medical conditions that they are used to treat. For example, drugs used to treat a heart condition are

listed under the category, “Cardiovascular Medication.” If you know what your drug is used for, look for the category name in the list that begins on page 76. Then look under the category name for your drug.

## **Alphabetical Listing**

If you are not sure what category to look under, you should look for your drug in the Index that begins on page 53. The Index provides an alphabetical list of all of the drugs included in this document. Both brand name drugs and generic drugs are listed in the Index. Look in the Index and find your drug. Next to your drug, you will see the page number where you can find coverage information. Turn to the page listed in the Index and find the name of your drug in the first column of the list.

## **What are generic drugs?**

Senior Care Options covers both brand name drugs and generic drugs. A generic drug is approved by the FDA as having the same active ingredient as the brand name drug. Generally, generic drugs cost less than brand name drugs.

## **Are there any restrictions on my coverage?**

Some covered drugs may have additional requirements or limits on coverage. These requirements and limits may include:

- **Prior Authorization:** Senior Care Options requires you [or your physician] to get prior authorization for certain drugs. This means that you will need to get approval from Senior Care Options before you fill your prescriptions. If you don’t get approval, Senior Care Options may not cover the drug.
- **Quantity Limits:** For certain drugs, Senior Care Options limits the amount of the drug that Senior Care Options will cover. For example, Senior Care Options provides 34 tablets per prescription for Abilify. This may be in addition to a standard one month or three month supply.
- **Step Therapy:** In some cases, Senior Care Options requires you to first try certain drugs to treat your medical condition before we will cover another drug for that condition. For example, if Drug A and Drug B both treat your medical condition, Senior Care Options may not cover drug B unless you try Drug A first. If Drug A does not work for you, Senior Care Options will then cover Drug B.

You can find out if your drug has any additional requirements or limits by looking in the formulary that begins on page 6. You can also get more information about the restrictions applied to specific covered drugs by visiting our Web site at [www.commonwealthcare.org](http://www.commonwealthcare.org).

You can ask Senior Care Options to make an exception to these restrictions or limits. See the section, “How do I request an exception to the Senior Care Options’ formulary?” on the next page for information about how to request an exception.

## What are over-the counter (OTC) drugs?

OTC drugs are non-prescription drugs that are not normally covered by a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan. Senior Care Options pays for certain OTC drugs. Senior Care Options will provide these OTC drugs at no cost to you. The cost Senior Care Options pays for these OTC drugs will not count toward your total drug costs.

## What if my drug is not on the Formulary?

If your drug is not included in this list of covered drugs, you should first contact Member Services and ask if your drug is covered. This document includes only a partial list of covered drugs, so Senior Care Options may cover your drug. You can contact Member Services at 1-866-610-2273, 24 hours a day, 7 days/week.

TTY/TDD users should call 1-866-322-7357. If you learn that Senior Care Options does not cover your drug, you have two options:

- You can ask Member Services for a list of similar drugs that are covered by Senior Care Options. When you receive the list, show it to your doctor and ask him or her to prescribe a similar drug that is covered by Senior Care Options.
- You can ask Senior Care Options to make an exception and cover your drug. See below for information about how to request an exception.

## How do I request an exception to the Senior Care Options' Formulary?

You can ask Senior Care Options to make an exception to our coverage rules. There are several types of exceptions that you can ask us to make.

- You can ask us to cover your drug even if it is not on our formulary.
- You can ask us to waive coverage restrictions or limits on your drug. For example, for certain drugs, Senior Care Options limits the amount of the drug that we will cover. If your drug has a quantity limit, you can ask us to waive the limit and cover more.

Generally, Senior Care Options will only approve your request for an exception if the alternative drugs included on the plan's formulary, or additional utilization restrictions would not be as effective in treating your condition and/or would cause you to have adverse medical effects.

You should contact us to ask us for an initial coverage decision for a formulary or utilization restriction exception. **When you are requesting a formulary or utilization restriction exception you should submit a statement from your physician supporting your request.** Generally, we must make our decision within 72 hours of getting your prescribing physician's supporting statement. You can request an expedited (fast) exception if you or your doctor believe that your health could be seriously harmed by waiting up to 72 hours for a decision. If your request to expedite is granted, we must give you a decision no later than 24 hours after we get your prescribing physician's supporting statement.

## What do I do before I can talk to my doctor about changing my drugs or requesting an exception?

As a new or continuing member in our plan you may be taking drugs that are not on our formulary. Or, you may be taking a drug that is on our formulary but your ability to get it is limited. For example, you may need a prior authorization from us before you can fill your prescription. You should talk to your doctor to decide if you should switch to an appropriate drug that we cover or request a formulary exception so that we will cover the drug you take. While you talk to your doctor to determine the right course of action for you, we may cover your drug in certain cases during the first 90 days you are a member of our plan.

For each of your drugs that is not on our formulary or if your ability to get your drugs is limited, we will cover a temporary 34-day supply (unless you have a prescription written for fewer days) when you go to a network pharmacy. After your first 34-day supply, we will not pay for these drugs, even if you have been a member of the plan less than 90 days.

If you are a resident of a long-term care facility, we will cover a temporary 34-day transition supply (unless you have a prescription written for fewer days). We will cover more than one refill of these drugs for the first 90 days you are a member of our plan. If you need a drug that is not on our formulary or if your ability to get your drugs is limited, but you are past the first 90 days of membership in our plan, we will cover a 34-day emergency supply of that drug (unless you have a prescription for fewer days) while you pursue a formulary exception.

Senior Care Options will provide current members with an emergency supply of up to 34-day supply (unless the prescription is written for fewer days) for all non-formulary medications including those that may have step therapy or prior authorization requirements, if the member has an unplanned level of care transition. An unplanned level of care transition could be any of the following:

- A discharge or admission to a Long Term Care facility
- A discharge or admission to a hospital, or
- Nursing facility skilled level change

## Senior Care Options' Formulary

If you have trouble finding your drug in the list, turn to the Index that begins on page 58. Remember: This is only a partial list of drugs covered by Senior Care Options. If your prescription is not in this partial formulary, please visit our Web site at [www.commonwealthcare.org](http://www.commonwealthcare.org) or call Member Services at 1-866-610-2273, 24 hours a day, 7 days/week. TTY/TDD users should call 1-866-322-7357 for additional help.

The first column of the chart lists the drug name. Brand name drugs are capitalized (e.g., EMEND, GEODON) and generic drugs are listed in lower-case italics (e.g., *cephalexin*, *fluconazole*).

The information in the Notes column tells you if Senior Care Options has any special requirements for coverage of your drug.

<b>1</b>	Drug Tier 1 indicates a generic drug.
<b>2</b>	Drug Tier 2 indicates a brand-name drug.
<b>3</b>	Drug Tier 3 indicates a higher cost brand-name drug.
<b>PAR</b>	The symbol PAR in the "Restrictions" column indicates that prior authorization may apply.
<b>QLL</b>	The symbol QLL in the "Restrictions" column indicates that quantities dispensed may be limited.
<b>ST</b>	The symbol ST in the "Restrictions" column indicates that Step Therapy may apply.
<b>LA</b>	The LA symbol in the "Restrictions" column stands for "limited access" and indicates that availability of the drug may be limited only to certain pharmacies.
